Key Facts

- We live on planet Earth
- Planet Earth is the only known planet to be able to support life
- Earth is the third planet away from the sun in the Solar System
- There are eight planets in the solar system: Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune
- Pluto is a dwarf planet. It is much smaller than any others
- The sun is a star
- Animals and insects visited space before humans
- Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin were the first people to walk on the moon
- Jackson Pollock was a painter who painted in an abstract style
- Colin McNaughton has written and illustrated over 70 children's books

1. **Space:** The area that contains the entire universe beyond the earth; outer space
2. **Astronaut:** A special kind of Scientist that takes a spaceship to outer space
3. **Rocket:** Rockets are devices that produce the force, or push, needed to move an object forward. Rockets are used to launch spacecraft.
4. **Moon:** The moon is a large natural object that orbits or travels around Earth
5. **Planet:** Planets are a large natural objects that orbit or travel around stars
6. **Solar System:** The solar system consists of the sun and everything that orbits or travels around the sun
7. **Sun:** The sun is the star at the centre of the solar system
8. **NASA:** Nasa is a US Space agency, that stands for the 'National Aeronautics and Space Administration'
